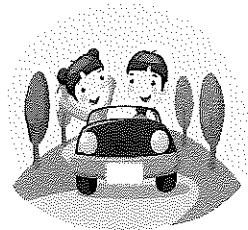
FORM D - PARENTAL CONSENT
