FINAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE TRIP.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our residential trip to Kingswood will soon be upon us, so here are the final details.

We are all getting very excited!!

Please arrive at school from 8.30am onwards and go to the <u>Key Stage 2 hall</u>. Please drop off your children's bags, any medication and money and then the children can come into class as usual at 8.50 am. We would prefer to settle the children in class before leaving, so please don't wait for us to go. Your co-operation with this is appreciated and should ensure minimum upset is caused by anyone feeling a little daunted.

The children will need a packed lunch, in a separate disposable bag, that they can take onto the coach for when we arrive. The children will also need a drink and a snack for the journey. Please keep sweets to a minimum- it is a long journey (about 2 and a half hours) and we don't want any sickness! Please ensure your child has taken their travel sickness medication, if needed, at home before setting off.

Please hand in any medication on arrival to a member of staff and sign the permission form. This includes travel sickness tablets for the return journey. Please put any medication in a named plastic bag.

Please also give to a member of staff your child's spending money approximately £5.00 in a named purse or wallet.




















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The children may also wish to bring books, magazines or playing cards for the journey. **No** electronic toys/phones/iPads/ tablets please, as these could be damaged, mislaid or stolen. Disposable cameras are the best if required.

Please bring clothes in a bag or case that your child can carry themselves. If it is on wheels, even better, as the children will have to carry the cases from the coach to the dormitories. Labelled clothing would ensure items are returned if mislaid. Old clothing which is comfortable for outdoor/muddy activities is recommended. As stated, most activities will require a long sleeved top. (see kit list) A waterproof coat is also required. Also, sun cream and a sun hat if the weather is warm. A black bin bag for very muddy clothes is essential!!

No bedlinen/sleeping bags are required, as all our bedding is provided. Towels are not provided.

Over the years, we have found it best if the children do not make contact with you during the stay, as it tends to be more unsettling for them. Any homesickness is usually very fleeting and we are all experienced in dealing with this, if it occurs. If there is an emergency and you need to contact us, you can contact school who can get in touch with us through our mobile phones.

We plan to leave the centre, to return home, at 1.30 pm on Friday, after lunch.

The estimated arrival time back will be between 4.00pm - 4.30 pm. We will make any updates on our progress through the school Facebook page.

Please complete the <u>Form C</u> for residential visits with up to date contact details and return to school as soon as possible. If there is any other information that you feel you need to share with us about the visit, please inform your class teacher.
