Half Term Learning	Our main focus this half term will be Geography. We will begin the unit by using simple fieldwork skills to study the geography of our school, the grounds and the key human and physical features of the environment. This will include making a plan of either the school or our own houses. After studying maps of Crewe we will make our own maps of the local area. Later in the half term, we will use maps and globes to explore the UK and will learn to name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries, capital cities and surrounding seas. Our art this term will focus on L.S.Lowry. We will find out about his life and work and will use sketching pencils, charcoal and pastels to create art in his style.
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Through our RE lessons our learning will be:	Following Jesus – to hear about how Jesus chose the first disciples and talk about how we choose our friends, to reflect on how we pray, to listen to stories from the Bible about being a follower of Jesus and to learn about the events of Easter and the time of waiting before it.
