Half Term Learning	<p>During this half term Class 6 will find out about the artist Lowry and make pictures and paintings in his style during our art lessons.</p> <p>In computing, we will use a range of applications and devices in order to communicate ideas, work and messages.</p> <p>In PE, we will learn how to be imaginative when performing and how to respond to art and music. We will then plan and perform a dance.</p> <p>Our Geography topic is to know how to draw a route around school and to name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the UK. We will describe some characteristics of each country in the UK. We will also name key physical features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be learning about keeping safe and personal relationships. We will also learn about keeping secrets and if they are good or bad to keep. We will learn to speak up when we are not happy.</p>
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Through our RE lessons our learning will be:	<p>Following Jesus</p> <p>We will hear how Jesus chose some of the first Disciples and consider how we choose friends. We will also hear the story of the Good Samaritan and reflect on the message it has for us as followers of Jesus. Learn about what it means to be a good friend.</p>
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	English	Maths
This half term our learning will be:	<p>We will learn new vocabulary from our topic work.</p> <p>We will continue to develop our reading skills and recognise and spell high frequency words.</p> <p>Using the story of 'Where the Wild things are' we will continue to remember to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, a question or exclamation mark as well as join two simple sentences using 'and'.</p> <p>We will use role-play to understand the character and plot in our story.</p>	<p>We will use and understand the language of length such as long, longer, short, shorter, tall, taller. We will recognise this language will change depending on what type of length we are describing and comparing. We will understand that height is a type of length.</p> <p>We will also introduce weight and mass for the first time. We will have some understanding of heavy and light from our own experience of carrying objects. We will begin by holding objects and describing them using vocabulary such as heavy, light, heavier than, lighter than before using the scales to check.</p>
