This half term our learning will be:	This half term the children will start by exploring 'Dougal's Deep Sea Diary'. They will write character descriptions, diary entries and write questions for the character. Then we will learn the story of 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. In our writing the children will continue to develop their own skills by writing their own descriptions. We will use familiar and new punctuation correctly as well as use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify. They will be planning their own version of the story, using a range of strategies.	In Maths, we will begin by Identifying and describe the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces ·We will Identify 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes and finally compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects. We will then move onto Fractions, where we will recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity. We will also be able to write simple fractions for example, 1/2 of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and ½. Finally, we will compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using >, < and =
