Half Term Learning

During this half term Class 9 will be exploring the theme, 'All Around the World.' The children will be naming and locating the world's seven continents and five oceans. They will be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, the continents and oceans. We will be looking at the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles. We will use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features. We will also be exploring the lives of significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. For computing this half term, the children will explore how a story can be presented in different ways, they will make a quiz about the class topic and make a presentation for the class.

Through our RE lessons our learning will be:

The Mass:

This topic is designed to develop the children's knowledge and understanding of the celebration of the Mass. The children will learn about the readings at Mass and why they should listen to them. They will know what happens at the Offertory and that the bread and wine are changed into Jesus.

This half term our learning will be:

English
This half term the children will start by exploring 'Dougal's Deep Sea Diary'. They will write character descriptions, diary entries and write questions for the character.

Then we will learn the story of 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. In our writing the children will continue to develop their own skills by writing their own descriptions. We will use familiar and new punctuation correctly as well as use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify. They will be planning their own version of the story, using a range of strategies.

Maths

In Maths, we will begin by Identifying and describe the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces ·We will Identify 2-D shapes on the surface of 3-D shapes and finally compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects.

We will then move onto Fractions, where we will recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity. We will also be able to write simple fractions for example, 1/2 of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and ½. Finally, we will compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using >, < and =
