Half Term Learning

During this final half term in Class 1 will listen to the stories The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Mrs Armitage on Wheels, Mr Gumpy's Outing and the Rainbow Fish. We will be looking at non-fiction books linked to minibeasts, transport and sea life. We will be observing how caterpillars change into butterflies; discovering different ways of travelling; and exploring the oceans.

On Friday 25th June we can bring our bike or scooter to school! We will be celebrating Sports Day in our class bubbles this year due to COVID but we will be bringing photographs home of the races we participate in.

Through our RE lessons our learning will be:

We will learn we call the Church the family of God and that we can all belong to this family. A church building is a holy place where we can all pray and are welcome. We will learn that Jesus is present in a special way in the tabernacle and he invites us to visit him. We will talk about and be thankful that lots of people help to look after the church for us and know why Sunday is a special day for us.

	English	Maths
This half term our learning will be:	We will be learning stories to retell through our talk for writing activities and creating our own tales in story telling time. We will learn new vocabulary from the books we share and use it when talking to our friends and teachers throughout the day. We will be continuing to learn the sounds diagraphs and trigraphs make in our phonics sessions and applying our segmenting and blending skills when reading and writing words and sentences. We will continue to practise correct letter formation of both upper- and lower-case letters. We will be reading books linked to our phonics and writing captions and sentences using our phonic and tricky word knowledge.	We will continue to identify numbers to 20 using a range of resources. We will recognise that digits 1-9 repeat after every full 10. We will be counting on and back beyond 10, starting from any number noticing the 1-9 repeated pattern. We will look at BIG numbers, starting with 100. We will be learning to double, halve, share and groups and what odds and evens look like in objects and numbers. We will continue to develop our spatial awareness and reasoning and continue to use mathematical language and learn mathematical vocabulary. We will explore the relationships between shape and number, copying and creating repeated patterns and symmetrical images and shapes.
