Half Term
LearningDuring this half term Class 4 will be comparing transport from different times as part of
our History work. We will learn to explain some ways in which cars and trains have
changed and developed over time. We will know that old trains were slower and ran on
steam but new trains are fast and run on electric. In Design and Technology, we will learn
how to make a moving picture of a rocket using levers, wheels and winding mechanisms.
In computing we will learn to add images or text to create an animated book. In art we will
be looking at the work of Van Gogh and his 'Starry night' painting which we will link to or
work in English.
In PE we will learn how to catch and throw a ball and to understand about using space
effectively.

This half term our learning will be:	This half term the children will be reading 'How to catch a star' by Oliver Jeffers as part of our Talk for write unit as well as reading poems to enhance their vocabulary and to practise their reading skills. We will continue to consolidate our work on er,est, ed endings as well as punctation marks including questions.	In Maths, the Children will build on their previous learning of numbers to 50 They will continue grouping in 10s to make counting quicker and more efficient. Children will be introduced to the hundred square and use it to count forwards and backwards within 100. As part of the work on money Children will recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins. They will use their knowledge of place value to match coins with equivalent values. For example, ten 1 pence coins is equivalent to one 10 pence coin. Finally, Children will be introduced to telling the time to the hour using an analogue clock.
