Half Term Learning	<p>During this half term Class 5 will be learning about how transport has changed over time. This will include finding out about the local railway and Bentley as well as comparing changes in space travel through the missions of both Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake.</p> <p>In D&amp;T we will use winding mechanisms to create a moving picture of a rocket zooming to the moon! In Computing we will make our own animations using 2animate on purple mash.</p> <p>Our P.E unit will be athletics and we will focus on the skills of running, jumping and throwing.</p> <p>In Music, as we are still unable to sing or play instruments, we are currently taking part in RockSteady Music School's online live streamed lessons and we are learning about rhythm and pitch as well as how these are layered to create compositions.</p>
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Through our RE lessons our learning will be:	<p><b>Miracles:</b> In this topic we explore the role of miracles in the life of Jesus. The children will learn that Jesus had the power to perform miracles and that he performed miracles to show his love and care for others. They will hear the stories of the Calming of the Storm, and the healing of the paralysed and blind man. They will reflect on the message of the miracle stories and on how they act towards others.</p>

This half term our learning will be:	<p>This half term the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To use capital letters for names of people, places, the personal pronoun I and at the beginning of a sentence.</li> <li>To begin to use some common prefixes and suffixes e.g. un-, -est, -ed, -ing and -er.</li> <li>To use and apply plural endings -s and -es.</li> <li>To join sentences using 'and'.</li> <li>To sequence sentences to form short narratives.</li> </ul>	<p>In Maths, we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Describe position, directions and movements. (half, quarter and three-quarter turns)</li> <li>Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour.</li> <li>Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals.</li> <li>Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations</li> <li>Given a number, identify one more or one less.</li> <li>Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.</li> </ul>
