Half Term Learning	<p>During this half term Class 6 will be comparing transport from different times as part of our History work. We will learn to explain some ways in which cars and trains have changed and developed over time. We will know that old trains were slower and ran on steam but new trains are fast and run on electric. In Design and Technology, we will learn how to make a moving picture of a rocket using levers, wheels and winding mechanisms. In computing we will learn to add images or text to create an animated book. In art we will be looking at the work of Van Gogh and his 'Starry night' painting which we will link to or work in English.</p> <p>In PE we will learn how to catch and throw a ball and to understand about using space effectively.</p>
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Through our RE lessons our learning will be:	<p>Miracles- In this topic the children explore the role of miracles in the life of Jesus. The children will learn that Jesus had the power to perform miracles and that he performed miracles to show his love and care for others. They will hear the stories of the Calming of the Storm, the healing of the paralysed and blind man. They will reflect on the message of the miracle stories and on how they act towards others.</p>

This half term our learning will be:	<p>This half term the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To use capital letters for names of people, places, the personal pronoun I and at the beginning of a sentence. To begin to use some common prefixes and suffixes e.g. un-, -est, -ed, -ing and -er. To use and apply plural endings -s and -es. To join sentences using 'and'. To sequence sentences to form short narratives. 	<p>In Maths, we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe position, directions and movements. (half, quarter and three-quarter turns) Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations Given a number, identify one more or one less. Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.
