This curriculum information will help you to help and support your child's learning this term. The Curriculum Map shows the main areas of learning that your child will undertake during this term.

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| <p>A summary of our learning for this half term:</p> | <p>During this half term we will be finding out about the history of toys and how they have changed over time. We will focus on comparing toys from when our parents and grandparents were young to the toys we play with now. We will be handling and looking at toys from the past and will ask and answer questions using both photographs and artefacts. The theme of toys will extend into our D&T lessons where we will be making our own soft toys using a running stitch. In art we will explore primary and secondary colours through colour mixing. We will learn how to hold a brush properly, make colour wheels and will mix our own colours to make pop art in the style of Andy Warhol. In computing we will be learning to log in to Purple Mash and will begin to explore grouping and sorting using 2DIY. We will talk about how to keep our password safe. We begin Year 1 with a Real PE unit, in which we will learn to balance on one leg, sidestep, hop, skip and gallop.</p> |

| <p>These are the main learning objectives that will be taught during this term:</p> | <p>Recognise and spell high frequency words. Compose a sentence before writing. Leave finger spaces between words. Begin to use capital letters for the word I and at the beginning of a sentence. Begin to use a full stop at the end of a sentence. Use phonic knowledge to help spell and read new words.</p> | <p>Read, write and order numbers to 20. Place numbers on a number track. Compare and order numbers and use the equals sign. When given a number, identify one more and one less. Form digits 0 – 9 correctly.</p> |
