This curriculum information will help you to help and support your child's learning this term. The Curriculum Map shows the main areas of learning that your child will undertake during this term.

A summary of our learning for this half term:

During this half term Class 8 will be exploring the theme of 'Taking Care.' We will be learning about animals, including humans. We will explore how animals have offspring which grow into adults. We will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) We will also begin to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

In Design and Technology, the children will cut, peel or grate ingredients safely and hygienically to create a fruit animal of their choice. In Computing we will use technology to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content through 2PaintAPicture programming. In Music we will be developing our skills by singing in tune and in unison with a group.

Key Vocabulary across the wider curriculum includes:

Through our RE lessons this term the pupils will study the following:

The Chosen People-

This topic is designed to develop the children's knowledge and understanding of God's beautiful world. It also helps the children appreciate that God created them because he loves them and that each person should thank God for the gifts of creation and help God look after the world.

These are the main learning objectives that will be taught during this term:

This half term the children in Class 7 will be exploring the story of Peter Rabbit. We will focus on sentence writing — learning what to write, sentence by sentence.

English

In our writing we will develop our use if use familiar and new punctuation correctly as well as using expanded noun phrases to describe and specify. Handwriting will be a major focus. Children will learn to form lower case letters and use appropriately sized spacing between words.

This half term the children in Class 7 will be learning all about Numbers to 100. We will focus on the following areas. Counting, reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals as well as counting in multiples of 2's, 5's and 10's. We will work on recognising the place value of each digit in 2-digit number, as well as comparing and ordering numbers from 0 up to 100; use <,> and = signs. We will develop our ability to recall and use addition and subtractions facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts to 100. Finally, we will begin to add and subtract numbers including: a 2-digit number and 1's, tens, and ones.
