This curriculum information will help you to help and support your child's learning this term. The Curriculum Map shows the main areas of learning that your child will undertake during this term.

<p>A summary of our learning for this second half term:</p>	<p>In Science we will begin our topic on Me, My World and I which looks at animals including humans. We will identify and name common animals, classify animals as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals and identify basic parts of the human body. In computing we will use Purple Mash to sort and group items. We will use direction keys to move characters and understand what an algorithm is.</p>

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<p>Through our RE lessons this term the pupils will study the following:</p>	<p>Theme - <u>Mary Our Mother – What makes someone special?</u> To learn about the events leading up to the Birth of Jesus, including the Annunciation and the Visitation. To know why Mary was chosen to be the mother of Jesus. To spread the Good News of Jesus's birth.</p>
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<p>My Happy Mind & Wellbeing sessions focus on:</p>	<p>Understanding how our brain works and how to ensure we look after it so that we can manage our emotions and be at our best. Growth mindset is a key part of this too.</p>
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	English	Maths
<p>These are the main learning objectives that will be taught during this term:</p>	<p>We will be continuing to develop our reading skills both in guided groups and across whole class learning. We will focus on recognising and spelling high frequency words and common exception words. We will begin to use capital letters for the word I and at the beginning of a sentence and end a sentence with a full stop. We will continue to use our phonic knowledge to help spell and read new words. In our writing we will write in simple</p>	<p>We will learn to read, write and order numbers to 20 and beyond and recognise and read two digit numbers and know the value of each digit.</p> <p>We will relate addition to counting on and subtraction to counting back. We will use subtraction as takeaway and use the related vocabulary. We will compare and order numbers and use the equals sign. We will describe simple patterns using shape and visualise and name common 2d and 3d shapes.</p>
