Personal,	How to use activities and resources with help.		
Social &	To enjoy responsibility for carrying out small tasks.		
Emotional	To show understanding and cooperate within some boundaries and routines.		
Development	To be interested in other's play and start to join in.		
·	To begin to accept the needs of others - take turns and share resources.		
Communication	To listen with interest to the noises adults make when they read stories.		
& Language	To show interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes.		
	To identify action words, e.g. "Who's jumping?"		
	To understand and use "Who", "What", "Where" in simple questions.		
	To use simple sentences when speaking.		
	To listen to others.		
	To follow simple directions.		
Physical	To begin to use a tripod grip to hold writing tools.		
Development	To begin to show preference for dominant hand.		
	To communicate need for toilet.		
	To help with clothing – unzipping zipper, taking off hat etc.		
	To run safely on whole foot.		
	To move freely with pleasure and confidence.		
	To handle tools - hole punches, torches etc.		
Literacy	To begin to be aware of the way stories are structured.		
	To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.		
	To suggest how a story might end.		
	To enjoy rhyming and rhythmic activities.		
	To show awareness of rhyme.		
	To distinguish between the different marks they make.		
	To sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint.		
Maths	To recite number names in a sequence.		
	To notice simple shapes and patterns in pictures.		
	To begin to use the language of size.		
	To recognise numerals 1-5.		
	To count reliably a small group of objects.		
	To categorise objects according to size.		
	To begin to use language of size.
