This curriculum information will help you to help and support your child's learning this term. The Curriculum Map shows the main areas of learning that your child will undertake during this term.

<p>A summary of our learning for this second half term:</p>	<p>During this half term we will begin a new Topic called What makes our world? We will use this theme to find out about materials as part of our science work. We will learn to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made as well as identify, name and describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.</p> <p>Our PE will begin with Real PE and how to be imaginative when performing and how to respond to art and music to plan and perform a dance.</p> <p>As part of our PSHE work we will learn about what it means to be part of a community and what it means to be British in our democracy days.</p> <p>Our Music curriculum will include making patterns with sounds. We will make and change sounds on an instrument. We will also understand how to explain which of two sounds is higher or lower. We will also sing in unison with a group.</p>

	English	Maths
<p>These are the main learning objectives that will be taught during this term:</p>	<p>We will continue to develop our reading skills and comprehension and recognise and spell high frequency words. We will use capital letters for names and at the beginning of a sentence more consistently. We will use our phonic knowledge to help spell and read new words. We will use and apply the magic e rule to make a long vowel sound.</p>	<p>We will continue to read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (–) and equals (=) signs. We will learn to represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. We will understand how to add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero. We will move higher with our counting to 50 and representing numbers to 50. We will learn counting in 2's and 5's.</p>

We will begin to use some common prefixes and suffixes e.g. un-, -est, -er, -ed, -ing.

We will introduce measuring lengths and heights and measures using a ruler.

We will compare, describe and solve practical problems for mass or weight [for example, heavy or light, heavier than, lighter than] and measure and begin to record mass/weight.
