This curriculum information will help you to help and support your child's learning this term. The Curriculum Map shows the main areas of learning that your child will undertake during this term.

<p>A summary of our learning for this half term:</p>	<p>During this half term Class 12 will start to compare the city of Chester with our town of Crewe. We will learn about the impact the Romans had on our country and how this can still be seen. The children will study local maps and create maps of our local area. We will also spend time learning about Crewe and its heritage and how our town has changed over time. During Science the children will learn about light and how we can make things easier to see at night. We will investigate shadows and how we can change the shape of them. PE will involve continuing their gymnastics and then moving outside to complete their athletics sessions. During French the children, be learning a French story called 'Les Quatre Amis' and starting to write simple sentences. The focus will also be on learning colours, the names of some animals and how they move. The children will continue their guitar tuition each week and learning to perform simple songs from memory. During the children's RHE sessions they will explore their relationship with the wider world and how they can serve their community.</p>

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<p>Through our RE lessons this term the pupils will study the following:</p>	<p>Celebrating Easter and Pentecost</p> <p>This topic is designed to develop the children's knowledge and understanding of Easter and Pentecost through the Story of Emmaus and through Acts 2: 1-13 (Pentecost). The children will reflect on the celebration of new life and on the signs and symbols of the Easter season. They will reflect on the importance of belief through the story of 'Doubting Thomas'. They will learn about the symbols and fruits of the Holy Spirit and reflect on how the Holy Spirit helps them to live their lives.</p>
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<p>My Happy Mind & Wellbeing sessions</p>	<p>Unit: Relate</p> <p>This module is focused on teaching children the importance of being able to relate or get along with others in order to have positive relationships. It uses the character strengths lens to illustrate the need to be able to see other perspectives in order to build relationships. Through lots of examples and discussion, the children learn about two key skills that will serve them well in relationship building; Active Listening and Stop, Understand and Consider.</p>
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<p>Ten:Ten Relationship and Health Education (RHE)</p>	<p>Religious Understanding – Children can describe that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God is Love as shown by the Trinity – a 'communion of persons supporting each other in their self-giving relationship.' • The human family can reflect the Holy Trinity in charity and generosity • The Church family comprises home, school and parish (which is part of the dioceses)
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Living in the Wider World – Children can explain:

- That God wants His Church to love and care for others
- Practical ways of loving and caring for others

	English	Maths
This half term our learning will be:	<p>Hansel and Gretel – Anthony Browne</p> <p>For our first piece of writing this half term the children will be entering the world of Anthony Browne’s version of Hansel and Gretel. With its stunning art work the children will be learning about atmospheric writing and how to create suspense.</p> <p>The Day the Crayons Quit – Persuasive Writing</p> <p>When some crayons are not being used often enough they decide enough is enough and quit! The children will be learning how to write persuasively to convince them to return to their crayon box to be used once again.</p>	<p>Fractions</p> <p>The children will continue their mathematical journey with fractions by learning about equivalent fractions, comparing fractions and then adding and subtracting fractions. At the end of the unit the children solve problems, applying all the new skills they’ve learned.</p> <p>Time</p> <p>Following on from fractions the children will learn about months, years, and how many hours in a day. They will estimate time, tell time to 5 minutes and the nearest minute. The children will compare different durations and measure time in seconds.</p>
