WHAT THE LAW SAYS:

Parents should not take pupils on holiday in term time. School will only consider holidays in term time where both:

- The application is made to the Head Teacher in advance of the holiday by a parent the child normally lives with and countersigned by the other parent
- There are exceptional reasons for needing to take the holiday.

HOLIDAYS IN TERM-TIME

IMPORTANT: Please read carefully the information below.

WARNING: If you take your child on holiday in term time without the prior approval of the school, you may be liable for a Fixed Penalty Notice per parent per child, in accordance with The Education (Penalty Notices) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.
