• SPOTSS Cheshire

The Sensory Processing Occupational Therapy Support Service (SPOTSS) for Cheshire, is a newly formed NHS service aimed at delivering tiered support to Autistic children or those with Autistic features who have sensory processing needs within their settings.

The service is currently delivering a core offer focusing initially on primary and secondary schools in Cheshire. The tiered service pathway consists of *universal*, *targeted/specialist* support. Within SPOTSS's Eventbrite collection you will be able to access training courses as part of the Universal support. These aim to provide participants with fundamental knowledge related to Sensory Processing and its impact on learning and development.

They are open to any member of school staff across Cheshire East and Cheshire West and Chester Schools.
